## **Documents Required**

- **1.** <u>National Visa application Form</u> Each applicant must complete and sign a visa application, filling in each of its sections (including email + phone number). If the applicant is a minor, one of their parents must sign the application
- 2. Photograph A recent, color photograph.
- **3. Valid passport** Original and a photocopy. The passport must have a minimum validity period of 4 months (in the case of a temporary contract, the validity period must cover the duration of the contract)
- **4. Work contract** A copy of the work contract stamped by the Foreign Nationals' Office.
- **5. Residence and Work Authorization** issued by the "Government Sub delegation Foreigners' Office," with signature and date of receipt.
- **6. Criminal record check certificate.** Criminal record (Bulletin n°3) issued by the country of origin and the country where the individual has resided for the last five years, with the issuance date being within the last 3 months (legalized and Apostilled).
- **7. Medical certificate** Readable <u>medical certificate</u>, stamped with the details to identify the issuing doctor, attesting that the individual does not suffer from illnesses listed in the International Health Regulations that could result in quarantine, with the issuance date being within the last 3 months (legalized and Apostilled).

## Remarks

All Documents must be submitted along with an <u>official translation</u> into Spanish. Parental consent for minors (under 18 years old)

This visa is intended for family members of foreigners who already have their legal residence in Spain and wish to exercise their right to family reunification.

This type of visa is not issued to family members of European Union nationals, members of European Economic Area states, or Switzerland (see "Visas for Family Members of EU Nationals").

## **General Remarks:**

- 1. ALL ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS MUST BE LEGALIZED.
- 2. DOCUMENTS NOT WRITTEN IN SPANISH MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN OFFICIAL TRANSLATION IN SPANISH.
- 3- ALL ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THEIR PHOTOCOPIES.
- 4- NON-TUNISIAN APPLICANTS MUST PRESENT THEIR RESIDENCE PERMIT IN TUNISIA.
- 5- MEDICAL CERTIFICATES MUST BE ISSUED BY A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE PHYSICIAN WITH THE STAMP OF THE REGIONAL HEALTH AUTHORITY.
