

Documents Required

- 1. [National Visa application Form](#)** Each applicant must complete and sign a visa application, filling in each of its sections (including email + phone number). If the applicant is a minor, one of their parents must sign the application
- 2. [Photograph](#)** A recent, color photograph.
- 3. [Valid passport](#)** Original and a photocopy. The passport must have a minimum validity period of 4 months.
- 4. [Initial family reunification authorization](#):** issued by the "Sub delegation of the Government - Foreigner's Office," with the resident's signature and reception date (the authorization takes 60 days)
- 5. Documents proving the family relationship with the sponsor:**
 1. Spouse: Recent marriage certificate issued by the Civil Registry of the country of origin of both spouses + birth certificates of both spouses (legalized and Apostilled).
 2. Child: Recent birth certificate(s) (legalized and Apostilled).
 3. Parent: Proof of relationship (legalized and Apostilled).
+ proof of economic dependency of the individual on the person wishing to reunify, reasons justifying the necessity of authorizing residence in Spain.
- 6. [Criminal record check certificate](#).** Criminal record (Bulletin n°3) issued by the country of origin and the country where the individual has resided for the last five years, with the issuance date being within the last 3 months (legalized and Apostilled).
- 7. [Medical certificate](#)** Readable [medical certificate](#), stamped with the details to identify the issuing doctor, attesting that the individual does not suffer from illnesses listed in the International Health Regulations that could result in quarantine, with the issuance date being within the last 3 months (legalized and Apostilled).
- 8. [Sponsor's residence card](#):** photocopy of the sponsor Residence card (valid for 2 months from notification date)

General Remarks:

1. ALL ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS MUST BE LEGALIZED.
2. DOCUMENTS NOT WRITTEN IN SPANISH MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN [OFFICIAL TRANSLATION](#) IN SPANISH.
- 3- ALL ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THEIR PHOTOCOPIES.
- 4- NON-TUNISIAN APPLICANTS MUST PRESENT THEIR RESIDENCE PERMIT IN TUNISIA.
- 5- MEDICAL CERTIFICATES MUST BE ISSUED BY A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE PHYSICIAN WITH THE STAMP OF THE REGIONAL HEALTH AUTHORITY.
